Student Materials Needed For Courses, Gr. 9-12 - 2009/2010

(This could be subject to change)

- English 9/10: 2 to 3 Pocket folders, loose leaf paper, writing utensils, 5-subject notebook.
- English 11/12: 5 subject notebook, homework folder, blue or black pens, 3 x 5 index cards if wanted for vocabulary flash cards (note cards not required).
- Global Studies 9: #2 pencils, 3-ring binder (optional), loose leaf paper, 5 subject notebook, blue/black ink pens, several pocket folders, colored pencils (optional), shoe box (child size would be ideal), 5 pks of 100 - 3 x 5 cards.
- Global Studies 10: 5 subject notebook, pens, loose leaf paper, #2 pencils, 5 packs of 100 3 x 5 cards.
- U. S. History: #2 pencils, blue or black ink pens, 1 pocket folder, colored pencils or markers.
- Govt./Econ.: #2 pencils, spiral notebooks, blue or black ink pens, pocket folders, colored pencils or markers.

- **Graphing Calculators**** Math B, Precalculus, and Calculus students will be issued a graphing calculator for use during the school year. For all other classes graphing calculators will be available for classroom work only. It is not mandated that a graphing calculator be purchased. However, if you wish for your child to have a calculator for use at home we recommend the TI 83 or TI 84.

- Integrated Science: Calculator, 2 notebooks, folder, colored pencils, ruler (cm), Lab folder, graph paper, binder w/loose leaf paper.
- Labs: Small assortment of colored pencils, pencils, ruler (cm), safety compass, protractor, 2 - 8 ½ x 11 file folders, pen, eraser.
- AP Biology: 3 ring binders, loose leaf paper and/or single subject notebooks, pens, pencils, several folders with pockets, Calculator with square root function.

Spanish 1B/Spanish II/Spanish III:	3 ring binder (medium size) - only for spanish, 5 divider sheets, loose leaf paper, 5 packs of 100: 3 X 5 cards. One large circle ring (metal) - to be used for cards
Spanish IV:	3 ring binder, loose leaf paper
Exploratory Spanish:	3 ring binder (medium size) - ONLY FOR SPANISH, 5 divider sheets, loose leaf paper, 1 pocket folder, 2 packs of 100 3 x 5 cards, one large circle ring (metal) - to be used for cards, pencils (PENS MAY <u>NOT</u> BE USED), colored pencils, crayons, glue stick, scissors, markers (optional).
Sr. Chorus:	Pencil for rehearsal, black pants or skirt and white dress shirt or blouse for concerts & festivals.
Concert Band:	Pencil for rehearsal. Black pants and skirt and white dress shirt for spring concerts and festivals.
Music in our Lives:	Notebook, pen, pencil, Music manuscript notebook (purchased after first class), Pocket Folder.
Art:	Pencils and erasers.
Lifeguarding:	Swimming suit, towel, goggles, \$24.00 for certification cards at end of course.
