<b>Adv. Biology &amp; Lab</b>	2.5" binder, loose leaf paper
<b>Algebra I</b>	Three-ring binder (may be shared with other subjects), pocket folder, pencils, blue or black ink Pens, three (3) AAA batteries
<b>Algebra II</b>	Three-ring binder (may be shared with other subjects), pencils, blue or black ink pens
<b>Anatomy &amp; Phys.</b>	2.5" binder, loose leaf paper
<b>AP US History</b>	1.5" Three-ring binder, lined paper, blue or black ink pens, pencils
<b>Art History</b>	3"x5" index cards
<b>Band</b>	Pencil for rehearsal, black pants or skirt & white shirt or blouse for concerts
<b>Business Math</b>	Notebook (may be shared with other subjects), pocket folder, blue or black ink pens
<b>Business &amp; Marketing Courses (all)</b>	Three-ring binder (may be shared with other subjects), pocket folder, pens, pencils, Chromebook (school issue)
<b>Calculus</b>	2" three-ring binder, loose leaf paper, pencils
<b>Chemistry &amp; Lab</b>	Three-ring binder, scientific calculator, pen/pencils, paper
<b>Chess</b>	Pens, pencils, pocket folder
<b>Chorus</b>	Pencils for rehearsal, black pocket folder, black pants/skirt/dress & black shirt/blouse for concerts and festivals
<b>College Algebra</b>	Three-ring binder or a pocket folder, pencils, blue or black ink pens
<b>College Statistics</b>	Three-ring binder or folder in which to keep handouts/note sheets, pencils, blue or black ink pens

<b>Earth Science &amp; Lab</b>	2" Three-ring binder, basic calculator, pens/pencils, colored pencils, metric ruler, lined paper
<b>Engineering Sci.</b>	½" Three-ring binder, pens/pencils, protractor w/ruler, graph paper
<b>English 9</b>	Three-ring binder with dividers, blue or black ink pens, #2 pencils
<b>English 10</b>	One (1) subject notebook, pens and pencils, Post-it notes, index cards
<b>English 11 &amp; 12, College Eng. 12</b>	One (1) subject notebook, homework folder, blue or black ink pens, 3x5 index cards, & post-it notes
<b>Geometry</b>	Three-ring binder (may be shared with other subjects), pocket folder, pencils, blue or black ink pens
<b>Global History 9 &amp; 10, Model OAS, AP Psych</b>	1.5" Three-ring binder with lined paper or a notebook, pocket folder, blue or black ink pens
<b>Gov't &amp; Economics</b>	#2 pencils, spiral notebooks, blue or black ink pens, pocket folders

<b>History of Disease</b>	1" binder, loose leaf paper
<b>HS Health</b>	Three-ring binder (any size), pens, pencils, lined paper
<b>Intro to Computers</b>	Pocket Folder
<b>Lifeguarding</b>	Swimming suit, towel, goggles, fee for certification card
<b>Living Env. &amp; Lab</b>	2.5" binder, two (2) composition notebooks, colored pencils
<b>Mod. ELA, Math, Sci. Social, &amp; Reading Lab</b>	Five (5) pocket folders, one (1) 1 subject notebook, pencils, erasers, two (2) 2" three-ring binders, two (2) pairs of earbuds/headphones
<b>Physical Education</b>	Sneakers, socks, athletic shorts/sweat pants, t-shirt or sweatshirt (No tank tops or spaghetti straps), swimming suit (girls should have competitive swim style suit), towel, goggles (not face mask), personal hygiene items
<b>Physics &amp; Lab</b>	2" Three-ring binder, scientific calculator, pens/pencils, protractor w/ruler, graph paper
<b>Spanish</b>	One (1) composition notebook, pocket folder (for Spanish only), loose leaf paper, pencils, one (1) red pen
<b>Statistics</b>	Three (3) subject notebook, pencils, pocket folder
<b>Studio Art</b>	Pencil box/case, pencils, erasers
<b>Textiles &amp; Design</b>	Small sketchbook, pencils, colored pencils
<b>US History 11</b>	Blue or black ink pens, pocket folder or binder, lined paper or a notebook, pencils
<b>Welding</b>	Pocket folder, paper, pens, shop clothes, sneakers or boots, jeans-no welding without these
